One Health is an exciting field that includes the collaborative effort of multiple disciplines - working locally, nationally, and globally - to attain optimal health for people, animals, and our environment. Over this four week, highly interactive course, students will travel across Texas and work together to learn about how to address the complex problems facing human, animal, and environmental health. The course will include:

- Veterinary health and zoonotic diseases

- Fieldwork and specimen collection/analysis
- Molecular diagnostics and countermeasure development
- Biosafety and biosecurity
- Clinical skills and reasoning
- Outbreak evaluation and response
- Socio-ecological systems thinking and political ecology
